

## AZERBAIJAN

The Cabinet of Ministers has adopted Decree No. 268 (16 September 2025), transitioning technical regulation and conformity assessment to electronic services. Paper certificates are replaced by electronic notifications and digital documentation for food safety compliance. The changes are effective immediately.

## KYRGYZSTAN

Decree No. 544 (1 September 2025) launches the Green Economy Development Program through 2029, aiming to improve waste management and introduce extended producer responsibility (EPR) for products and packaging. The Ministry of Economy and Commerce oversees implementation.

## MONGOLIA

Order No. A/337 (25 August 2025) introduces a unified, electronic customs clearance process for all foods. Importers must submit digital cargo manifests and supporting documents in advance. Foods are subject to document verification and sample analysis (“amber” or “red” status). Discrepancies trigger stricter inspection, possible import bans, or product disposal.
