

AZERBAIJAN

President signed order to create an integrated Digital Logistics Platform to support real-time data exchange and smart cargo flow management. The Digital Development and Transport Ministry to lead the rollout.

MONGOLIA

Parliament approved an Interim Trade Agreement with the Eurasian Economic Union, opening duty-free trade for 367 categories of goods. The 3-year agreement will diversify Mongolia's export, speed up customs procedures, and support long-term plans for a full free trade zone.

UZBEKISTAN

President signed order introducing 20% cut in customs fees and interest-free deferred payments for pre-declared goods. Additional measures introduce flexible payment of customs duties as well as automated e-processing of low-risk sanitary and epidemiological documents.

UZBEKISTAN

Cabinet of Ministers adopted decree excluding vegetables, alcoholic beverages, and salt from the list of goods, which require sanitary and epidemiological inspection report. No new product categories were added.
