

## ARMENIA

The government grants access to the ID tagging monitoring system to regulators: food safety inspection authority, market oversight authority, sanitary labor inspection, and the Commission for Competition and Consumer Protection.

## AZERBAIJAN

Food Safety Agency opens public access to register of foods and businesses that fail to comply with mandatory requirements on its website. The move aims to create additional incentives for food manufacturers and importers to comply with safety standards.

## KYRGYZSTAN

Cabinet of Ministers approved the Action Plan for implementing the National Development Program 2030. The document includes plans to launch the national brand of organic and halal products, with its own logo, packaging and marketing strategy.

## UZBEKISTAN

Cabinet of Ministers adopted additional measures on mandatory ID tagging system. Key provisions include pilot project on ID tagging of vegetable oils, implementation of automatic violation detection, and establishment of Tax Inspectorate for compliance monitoring.
